The Political & Regulatory Landscape in DC

- President Nominates FCC Commissioners
 - President selects chairperson
 - 3/2 majority for President's political party
- Commissioners are confirmed by the Senate
- FCC is directly responsible to Congress
 - Overseen by Senate Committee on Commerce, Science, & Transportation
- FCC is independent of the Executive Branch



Differences Between ILECs & ISPs

• ILEC

- Voice & Broadband
- Highly Regulated
- ISPs
 - Primarily Broadband
 - Lightly Regulated
- Same network & customers
