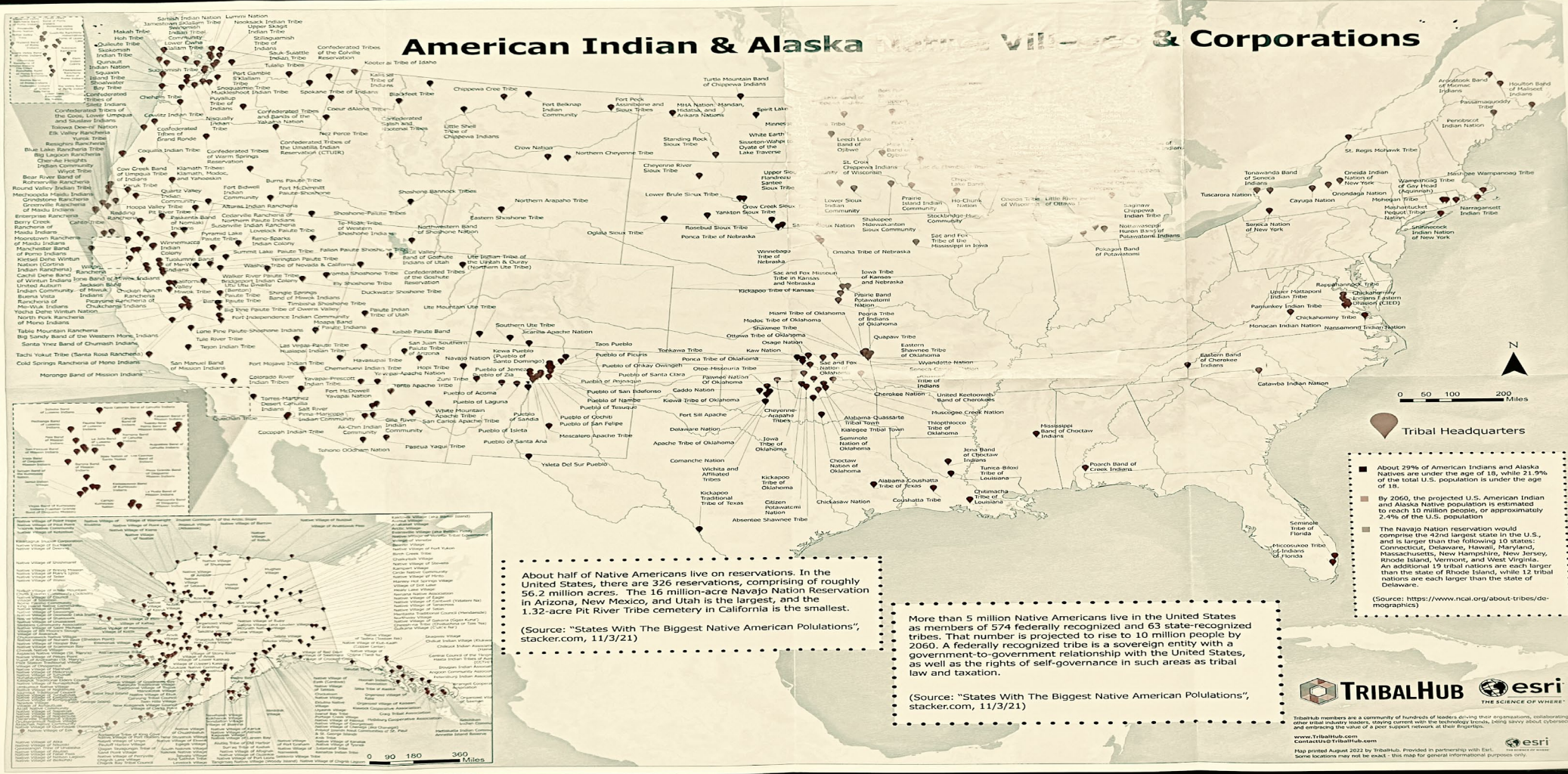

• About half of Native Americans live on reservations. In the United States, there are 326 reservations, comprising of roughly 56.2 million acres. The 16 million-acre Navajo Nation Reservation in Arizona, New Mexico, and Utah is the largest, and the 1.32-acre Pit River Tribe cemetery in California is the smallest.

• More than 5 million Native Americans live in the United States as members of 574 federally recognized and 63 state-recognized tribes. That number is projected to rise to 10 million people by 2060. A federally recognized tribe is a sovereign entity with a government-to-government relationship with the United States, as well as the rights of self-governance in such areas as tribal law and taxation.

- About 29% of American Indians and Alaska Natives are under the age of 18, while 21.9% of the total U.S. population is under the age of 18.
 - By 2060, the projected U.S. American Indian and Alaska Native population is estimated to reach 10 million people, or approximately 2.4% of the U.S. population.
 - The Navajo Nation reservation would comprise the 42nd largest state in the U.S., and is larger than the following 10 states: Connecticut, Delaware, Hawaii, Maryland, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, New Jersey, Rhode Island, Vermont, and West Virginia. An additional 19 tribal nations are each larger than the state of Rhode Island, while 12 tribal nations are each larger than the state of Delaware.

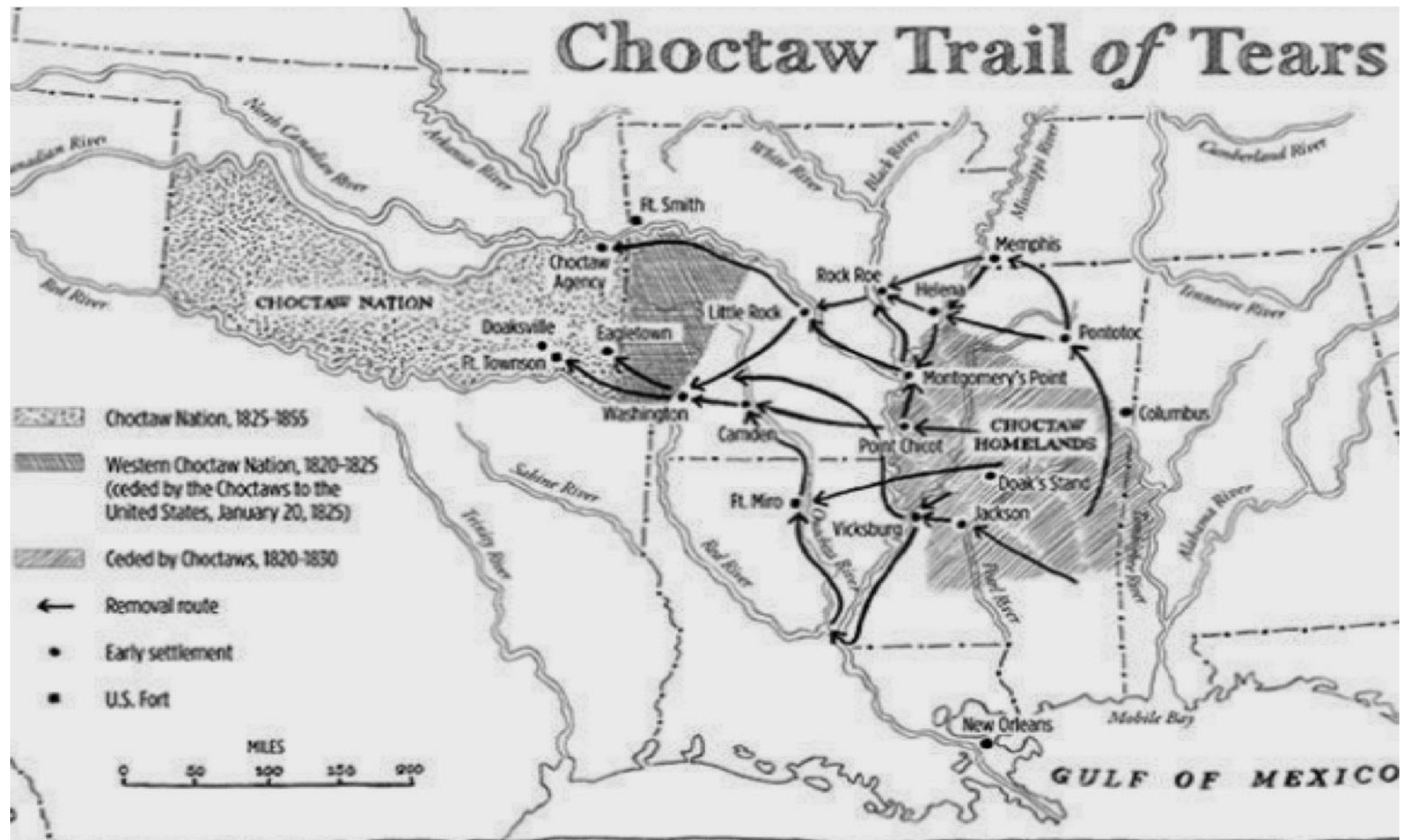

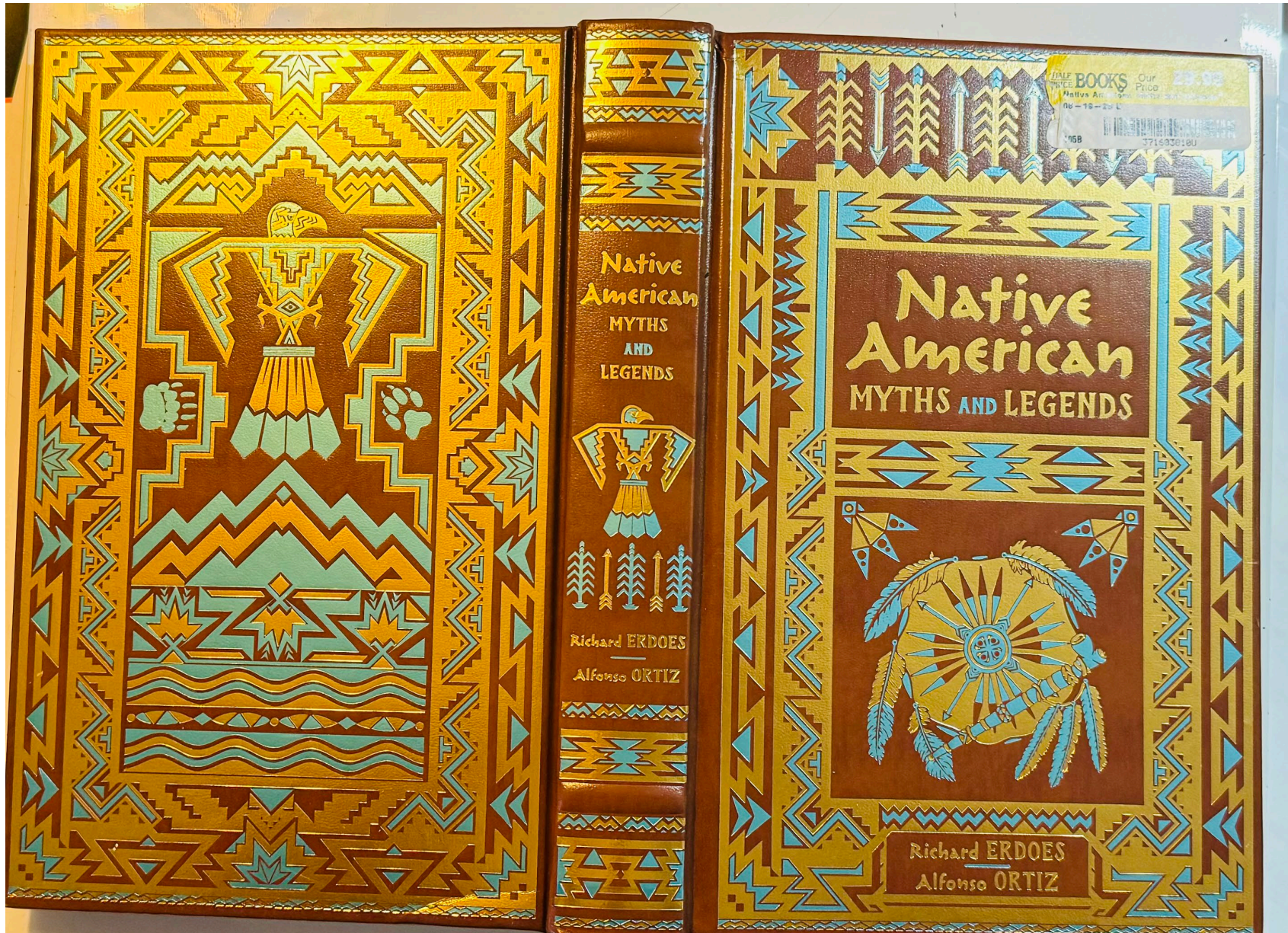

WHAT IS SOVEREIGNTY?

- Inherent (predates U.S. Government)
 - Not granted by any government.
 - Tribes were self governing societies long before contact with European nations. Unwritten laws and behavior guided by norms of conduct.
 - Most Tribes have adopted written constitutions.
 - Recognized in treaties, court decisions and U.S. Constitution.
 - Distinct independent political communities-self governing.
 - Separate and independent from Federal and State Governments.
 - Inherent powers have never been extinguished.
