The AMBER alert uses the Child Abduction Emergency (CAE) Event Code.



Authenticated emergency and life-saving information is delivered to the public using the Integrated Public Alert and Warning System (IPAWS).



Radio and television using the Emergency Alert System (EAS)



Cell phones using Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEA)



National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) Weather Radio.

Only Alerting Authorities can use Event Codes



The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) establishes new Event Codes and maintains the list of approved Event Codes.


State, Tribal, local, and territorial Alerting Authorities use IPAWS to issue non-weather Event Codes for emergencies and early


QR Code for NPM's Missing and Endangered Person (MEP) Resolution passed by the National Congress of American Indians.




On March 14, 2024, the FCC voted to propose MEP **Event Code** rules.
